

Leonardslee – year round exhibition

We are delighted that our collaboration with Leonardslee Lakes and Gardens now takes the form of a year-round exhibition.

This means that there is a “rolling” selection of pieces, with the Exhibition Manager (Abby Martin) selecting pieces on an ongoing basis as pieces sell or are moved within the gardens. We have freedom to exhibit anywhere in the gardens so there is potential for plenty of sculptures and bespoke settings.

Leonardslee – a brief overview:

As you may know, Leonardslee is an energetic venue that is undergoing a multi-year renovation and rejuvenation program.

They have ambitious plans, and we think this is a venue that we can support and grow along with.

On top of the obvious charms of the gardens they also have a Michelin-starred restaurant and their own, producing vineyards, so they attract a very broad range of visitors – which can only be a positive for potential sales.

They organise many events and themed attractions throughout the year (check their website) and are very focussed on utilising all social media streams – this can only benefit our sculptors over the long term.

Key points for sculptors:

NO REQUIREMENT TO STEWARD. Sales will be made via Leonardslee and SSS will pay you (less commission) as normal.

Apply in the usual way using Cognito form on the [SSS website](#). The application forms are open all year. As well as the outdoor trail, there is some space for indoor pieces (albeit on a limited basis) and we also have room in the Leonardslee shop.

We can offer a longer-term installation of your pieces, but we reserve the right to change the display without bias or explanation. We want to keep it fresh and exciting for both regular and occasional visitors.

A 30% commission rate will be charged on sales. A £10 application fee will be taken as normal for every piece exhibited outdoors or for longer term indoor display items. If your work is exhibited in the shop and you have a number of small pieces which will be rotated throughout, then we will charge a fee of £10 per artist (rather than £10 per piece).

All sizes, styles, mediums of work will be considered but they **must be durable all year round and very securely installed**.

Set up will be discussed for each phase of the exhibition with the participating artists.
