## **Surrey Sculpture Society Exhibition at the Landmark Arts Centre, Teddington**

Members of the Surrey Sculpture Society will be exhibiting at the Landmark Arts Centre in Teddington, TW11 9NN, from February 25<sup>th</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> March. This free to attend, accessible event is open to all from 10am to 5pm for nine days, including weekends.

The exhibits will be many and varied – over 140 works from 46 different artists. All work is for sale. As well as exhibiting pieces by experienced sculptors such as Signature Artist, Jeremy Mouldsdales, whose soaring uplifting pieces can be seen around the UK, prize winning students from UCA Farnham and the Art Academy, London will also have their work showcased during the event.

At the weekends, there will be live sculpture demonstrations on Saturday and Sunday mornings at 11 am and then from 2pm, a chance to participate in all-age “Have a Go with Clay” sessions. During the week, the Society will, as usual, be welcoming local school children to the event.

“Whilst visitors obviously come to The Landmark Arts Centre in Teddington to enjoy a fantastic exhibition of our members’ artwork, our time is also devoted to engaging with the community in as many ways as we can”, said SSS Exhibition Manager, Caroline Wheaton. It is a pleasure for us as artists to share our practice and the passion we share for sculpture. We hope that we may even pave the way for new artists in the future.”

“The Society has three core aims”, continues Caroline, “To promote interaction between sculptors, to organise exhibitions of our members’ work and to encourage, and promote education in, an appreciation of sculpture. We feel privileged at Landmark to achieve all three.”
